Time: **Arrive** at the St. Francis parking lot **at 7:30 AM on Saturday morning**. Scouts will return to St. Francis early-to-mid afternoon Sunday.

We will camp at a private campground near the water at Nanticoke, Maryland. With a view overlooking the Nanticoke River and Tangier Sound, the natural beauty of Roaring Point Waterfront Campground makes it a quiet, peaceful retreat to camp and explore. Scouts will have the opportunity to fish from a beach and a pier. Scouts should bring their own gear. (Scouts under the age of 16 don't need a fishing license; adults and older boys can obtain a MD license from the sport shop near the campground or prior to the trip. Please bring \$6 cash) Saturday afternoon new scouts will have the opportunity to work on their Tenderfoot, Second or First Class requirements.

We will bring our trailer with all troop and patrol equipment, and as always, meals are planned and prepared by patrols. Patrols are responsible for Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday breakfast. Scouts should either eat breakfast at home or bring a meal for the car on Saturday morning. Scouts may want to bring a snack to eat during the return trip on Sunday, as it is a 3-hour drive. Scouts should remember the potential need for layered clothing when they pack, and they should bring a warm sleeping bag. It may be cold in the evening.

There is a \$35 fee (\$20 transportation, \$4 campsite and \$11 patrol meals) for each scout and parent attending. **THE TRANSPORTATION FEE IS WAIVED FOR BOTH SCOUT AND PARENT IF THE PARENT IS DRIVING.**
