Where: Assateague National Seashore

Time: Meet at St Francis Church parking lot at 8:30 AM on Saturday morning. Scouts will return mid to late afternoon on Sunday. Please be on time.

On Saturday morning we will drive to Assateague National Seashore on Maryland's eastern shore and we will camp within a short walking distance of the ocean in the group campgrounds. After our arrival shortly after noon, scouts will prepare and eat lunch in patrols. During the afternoon we will explore the island with hikes to several locations. Scouts should come prepared for day hiking on Saturday which means hiking shoes, water bottles, and sun protection. Saturday evening we will have a campfire on the beach and each patrol will be responsible for a component of the campfire program.

Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast will be prepared by patrols. We will break camp after breakfast Sunday. Drivers will stop for lunch on Sunday so please bring money.

The cost of the trip is \$33 plus Sunday lunch money. This includes transportation, tolls, camping fees and 3 meals.
