



Whitetail Mountain Ski Weekend

When: February 2-4, 2018

Where: Whitetail Mountain, Mercersburg, PA

Lodging: Joy El Camp & Retreats

Time: Meet at the St. Francis parking lot **at 6:00 PM**, Friday, February 2nd
Returning late afternoon, Sunday February 4th

Scouts will enjoy skiing/snowboarding at Whitetail Mountain resort in Mercersburg, PA. on Saturday and Tubing on Sunday. The troop will spend Friday and Saturday night at Joy El Camp and Retreats in group cabins – about 25 minutes from Whitetail Resort.

The Troop 55 basic package: \$170

Includes Friday and Saturday night lodging, breakfast, bag lunch, and dinner on Saturday, breakfast and lunch on Sunday, evening snacks, and tubing lift ticket on Sunday. Scouts must select their ski/snowboard options from the choices below. Ski or snowboard equipment is available for rent, and rental rates include the price of the ski lift ticket. More information about what to bring will be explained at the Troop meeting. Joy El lodging includes: basketball court & game room (foosball, table tennis, air hockey, fireplace).

If Scouts plan on staying for night skiing Saturday evening, they should bring cash for dinner on Saturday. Scouts not interested in night skiing will be transported back to Joy El and dinner will be provided.

Ski/Snowboard Options (Scouts can ski/board 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday):

All Mountain lift ticket only (have own equipment, including helmet): \$69

Group EZ learn to ski or snowboard package*: \$90

Group all mountain package: \$104**

* **Group EZ Learn to Ski or Snowboard** - This package is designed for beginner skiers or snowboarders ages 8 and up. Package includes a lift ticket for beginner terrain, rental equipment (includes helmet), and a beginner lesson. EZ Learn To Package also includes lesson and rental equipment.

** **Group All Mountain Package** - This package is designed for the skier or snowboarder who is comfortable on all terrain. Package includes a lift ticket that is valid on all open terrain, rental equipment (includes helmet), and a group lesson.

Note: BSA regulations require a helmet. If you are not renting and plan on bringing your own equipment, but do not have a helmet, you must purchase a helmet rental.

To secure your place on the trip, full payment is due by January 26, 2018.
